



HUNTING AT OLIVE GROVE GUEST FARM – 2012

FEATURES:

1. Seven 3 Star Mountain View Self Catering Chalets. Two bedrooms, one with a double bed and the other with two single beds, fully equipped kitchen, bathroom and lounge with sleeper couch.
Chalets have own braai facilities.
Air conditioned / heated and DSTV.
There are also six Olive Orchard Guest Rooms ,each with a queen size bed as well as a single bed in a nook, Bathroom with Shower, DSTV and Climate control.
2. Restaurant for all your catering needs.(Karoo mutton is our speciality)
3. Swimming pool with braai facilities.
4. Walking trail.
5. Boma with braai / potjie facilities.
6. Farm size +/- 5100ha.
7. Karoo Mutton and Olive Products for sale.
8. Karoo National Park only 17km away.
9. Quad bike rental, Yamaha 125, R100,00/1/2 hr and Honda 250, R150,00/1/2 hr.

SITUATION:

From Cape Town direction, turn right on the N12, Oudtshoorn Road. (About 5km before Beaufort West).

Drive about 15km on the N12; find Olive Grove Guest Farm on the left hand side.

From Gauteng direction, drive through Beaufort West.

1,5km past the Karoo National Park entrance, turn left on the N12, Oudtshoorn Road, 15km, find Olive Grove Guest Farm on the left hand side.

WE ARE ABOUT 20KM SOUTH WEST OF BEAUFORT WEST.

Hunters have to book at least two nights accommodation.

MEAT PROCESSING:

1. We will only quarter or cut carcasses for cooking purposes or for ease of transportation. Quartering is R50/carcass Biltong / wors can be done by a processor in town.
2. Guests are welcome to use our bandsaw, wors stopper and other equipment if they please, at their own risk, free of charge.
3. In the case where hunters need help from our staff for processing meat, the cost is R50/hr/hunter.
4. We have a cool room on the property.

RULES:

1. All wounded animals to be paid in full, regardless of any circumstance. Rather take your time to get a decent shot, than a hurried mess.If there is **any** blood found from an animal , the animal is wounded !
2. Due to the fact that we have a huge reduction in game numbers, there is to be very limited hunting. We have 3 Gemsbok bulls, trek Kudus, only 15 Springbok and 4 Steenbok rams available for hunting this year. Hunters will be restricted to one buck/hunter.
3. Smallest caliber generally allowed is .243 win. (excepting on Gemsbok)

4. No bullets in breach or magazine when on the back of a vehicle and bolts to be left open.
5. Always treat a weapon as loaded, even if it is not.
6. **Minimum of two night's accommodation** i.e. no one day hunts. (Normal conditions apply). Generally the hunting week is divided into two where guests can **book in on a Sunday and hunt until Tuesday afternoon, process meat on the Wednesday morning and then book out. The next period is where guests can book in on a Wednesday , hunt Thursday and Friday and then process meat on the Saturday morning** .Guests are welcome to book longer if they wish to just relax and un-wind.
7. **NO** hunting on Saturdays or Sundays, unless looking for a wounded animal.(rates apply)
8. Hunters must have their own hunting licenses.
9. An indemnity form is to be filled in by all hunters/non hunters on a hunt.
10. Hunters **must** have their own licensed firearms, new legislation makes it illegal to borrow and lend firearms unless the lender and borrower hunt in the presence of each other.
11. All firearms (**including airguns**) being used for target shooting may only be used on the shooting range.**No** shooting of birds or targets near the chalets or anywhere else on the farm is allowed.
12. Hunters **must** be accompanied by a guide.
13. Refrain from giving staff liquor.
14. **NO LIQUOR IS ALLOWED IN THE VELD.NO HUNTING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF LIQUOR OR DRUGS.If this regulation is ignored, hunters will be asked to vacate the property and be liable for the full accommodation fee.**
15. **DEAD SILENCE** after 10pm, consider other guests that may be on the farm.
16. **Make sure all members of the hunting party read this document.**
17. No collecting of firewood. Bring your own or purchase from us.
18. Hunt ethically and enjoy this wonderful land of enchantment.

Please let us know if there are other species you want to hunt and we will **try** to source them.
